Value Based Education

It is a matter of deep regret and concern that with the gradual advancement of modern civilization, human beings are perpetually forgetting their moral and ethical values which are the essential ingredients needed for the holistic development of a human being. As a result, the 21st century is experiencing the most heinous crimes. According to the National Council for Primary and Secondary Education (1985) the crisis of values our society is passing through "Demands more explicit and deliberate educational efforts towards value development".

Keeping the utmost necessity of value education in mind, the school has taken certain steps to kindle the basic humanistic values like love, sympathy, patriotism, generosity, compassion, co-operation, fellow-feelings, spirituality etc. in the soft and tender minds of the children for their moral and ethical development. As the concept of value education is a bit abstract, the attainment of it is a little bit difficult. It can only be injected into the sub-conscious level of the psyche of the learners through various value based activities. The school makes the pupils practice various disciplines through its pledge, prayer, Life Skill Classes etc. so that value education unconsciously becomes a part of their lives. All these disciplines will ultimately help the students to cope up with any adverse circumstance, to be ready to face any hindrance in their lives and finally it will help them to be an important and integral part of the society by the development of their moral and behavioural characteristics.

As per the guidelines of CBSE it has been stated to all concerned in the school that bullying is strictly prohibited inside the school premises and no such act will go un-noticed or un-punished. An Anti-Bullying Committee has been constituted to check into bullying activities and creating awareness through different methods.

Total school campus is considered as anger free zone and team members of U. P. Public School taking every care for that.

Gender sensitivity

It is the ability to recognize gender issues. Teachers have attended workshops for the same & have engaged themselves in building gender awareness among students & explain the reason of the concept of gender so that the students realize that gender is socially constructed and different from sex. As a result the children can differentiate between biological roles & social roles & realize that women or girls are capable of playing roles normally played by men/boys & vice versa.

All members of the school have been made aware of the POCSO Act 2012, some of which cast a duty on them to report instance of child abuse. A special committee has been formed to serve as complaints and re-dressal body. Information from complaint boxes/other sources (CCTV etc.) immediately taken care of by the Guidance and counseling team.

To foster sensitization of Child Sexual Abuse a film titled 'KOMAL' was viewed by all the students and the staff in the last session.

Activities & Projects

The activities & projects in various subjects (Subject Enrichment) were mostly done within the campus during school hours. The school being situated in the lap of nature gives ample opportunity to the children to relate their knowledge to the natural surroundings or real life situations. Emphasis was given on multidisciplinary linear projects & reuse of waste materials was encouraged.

I) SCIENCE COUNCIL

In this world, our way of life is completely dependent on science and its fruits surround us on all sides. To impart this view in general, our School provides opportunity to share science topic in the assembly. It is compulsory to share the science topic for the class conducting the Assembly. The Science Council has successfully conducted the following:

- 2) Has made arrangement for special guidance classes for students appearing for Talent Exams for Std I to STD V on Saturdays
- 3) Organized Science Exhibition as Quest Carnival in school in a grand way.

JOURNALISM CLUB: Launched on 1st August, 2011, Journalism Club, an initiative of the English Department, nurtures and promotes the young minds to hone their writing skills. It came out with its 5th issue- The Monsoon Issue in August, 2020 available in our an e-newsletter with writings by the budding authors and Junior Reporters.

Time to time the Teacher members hold special sessions with the budding authors to make them aware of the current trends of writing and the fine touches they need to know.

- II) **DISASTER MANAGEMENT CLUB:** As an integral part of Social Science syllabus, students participated in activities , projects and mock- drill to tackle real life situations like Fire- Break , Earth Quake and Road Accidents. The utility of this was observed when earth quake did occur and the Disaster Management Team performed remarkably well.

This year school students donated new and used cloths, copies, crayons, biscuits etc. to the flood victims of North Bengal.

- III) **ECO CLUB:** Since inception Eco-Club has been permeating awareness among the learners to inculcate the importance of environment into the growing up process of our future generation. During ‘ Freedom Fighters’ Fortnight Celebration from 12th to 16th August, 2019, saplings were planted by the students outside as well as in the school premises.
